(Washington, DC)— The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close the right lane and shift the traffic pattern on northbound Minnesota Avenue, NE from Grant St, NE to Hayes St, NE. Northbound traffic will be shifted to the center of the roadway and one lane of traffic in each direction will be available at all times. This activity will run continuously behind barricades from 7:00 am Monday, May 20, 2019 through 7:00 pm Saturday, June 8, 2019, weather permitting.

This work is a part of the ongoing Minnesota Avenue Phase II Rehabilitation Project and is required for roadway reconstruction.

Pedestrians and motorists are urged to use caution as they travel in these areas, to anticipate moderate delays, and to be mindful construction personnel.
